Well-Child Care

Well-child visits are essential for keeping your child healthy. Dedicated time with your child's health care provider provides an opportunity to discuss your child's growth and development.

Each well-child visit includes a complete physical examination, a nutritional evaluation, and screenings for safety, tobacco use, and coping skills.

The health care provider will record your child's height, weight, and other important information. Hearing and vision screenings and blood tests may be part of the visit. Blood tests to screen for lead levels are routine at 12 months and 2 years of age.

Immunizations

Immunizations are provided at each well-child visit starting at 2 months of age.

Flu shots are offered each year October 1st – March 31st. The Upper Great Lakes Family Health Center hosts flu clinics several days throughout the season. Flu shots are also available at all routine well-child appointments during these months.

Well-child appointments begin with a newborn visit shortly after your child is born. The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends a well-child visit at:

- 1 month
- 2 months
- 4 months
- 6 months
- 9 months
- 12 months
- 15 months
- 18 months
- Annually beginning at 2 years

Immunization Schedule

2 months	Dtap, Hep B, HiB, PCV 13, IPV, Rotavirus
4 months	Dtap, PCV 13, HiB, Rotavirus, IPV, Hep B (if not given at birth)
6 months	Dtap, Hep B, HiB, PCV 13, IPV
9 months	Hep B (if needed)
12 months	PCV 13, Hep A, MMR
15 months	Dtap, Varicella, HiB
18 months	Hep A
4-5 years	Dtap, MMR, IPV, Varicella
6 mo.-10 years	Flu annually (October-March)

***Many vaccines are available as combination shots. Please ask your provider for more information**
